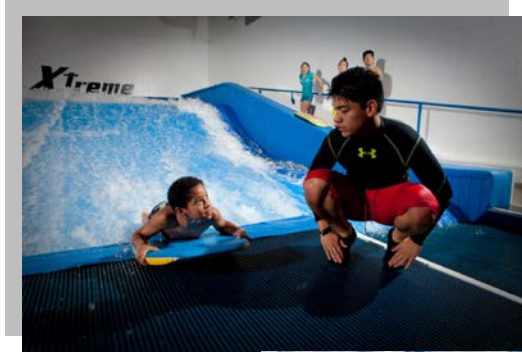

Dear Parents:

Welcome to the Truckee Donner Recreation & Park District Camp Radical Summer 2017 for students entering grades 6-10 in the fall. This year camp begins June 27th and runs through August 24th. This packet contains important information for all camp activities. Please read through this packet thoroughly and carefully.

Completed forms and payment are due upon registration.

CAMP RADICAL

Program Goals & Activities:

We strive to provide a safe and fun recreational program, with an emphasis on regional attractions and the outdoors. Experienced and trustworthy staff are hired and trained to meet the needs of all campers. Many of our activities are all day activities due to the active nature of kids in this age group. Staff will include the occasional team building activity to add to the fun.

In order to meet camper's needs this program will:

- Promote safety first

- Promote positive camper-camper interactions and camper-staff interactions

- Encourage campers in developing decision-making skills

- Provide recreational, social and academically oriented activities and challenges

General Schedule:

Camp Radical runs Monday through Thursday from 7:15 AM – 6:00 PM. Please remember to **ALWAYS PICK UP A WEEKLY AGENDA EITHER FROM THE CAMP RAD ROOM OR THE FRONT OFFICE.** Each day we will leave from, and return to the **Community Arts Center (10046 Church St)**. We will leave by **9:00 AM** each day for our activity so make sure your camper is at the Center **by 8:30am**. There **WILL BE** days where we will leave earlier or return a little later than the regular times, these will reflect on the weekly agenda. Many of our activities require us to leave right on time so **WE CAN NOT WAIT FOR YOU.** Please call and let us know if you are not attending for any reason by 8:00 am. This gives the people on the waitlist a chance to attend and staff a chance to adjust arrangements as needed. Campers **MUST** be picked up by 6:00 PM each day! **A late fee of \$5 will be charged at 6:01 PM and \$25 for pickup between 6:05 and 6:15 PM.** If a camper is not picked up by 6:30 PM, and the Camp Counselor is not able to make contact with parent, or other emergency contact, (as specified on the camper's emergency form); the student will be placed in the custody of the Town of Truckee Police Department. Continual late pickup may result in permanent dismissal from camp.

For trips returning after 5PM, you may call (530) 448-9716 after 5:30PM (on the day of the trip) to hear a voice message stating where we are in route

What to Bring:

- ✓ **SWIMSUITS EVERYDAY!**
- ✓ (Ladies, please no string bikinis...they just don't work!)
- ✓ Good shoes (for most days)
- ✓ Substantial sandals (i.e. *Tevras*, or like) for water days/activities
- ✓ Lunch and Snacks (we have long days in the sun so pack extra)
- ✓ Towels, spare layered clothing for changing conditions
- ✓ Lots (minimum 1 liter) of **DRINKING WATER DAILY**
- ✓ **SUNSCREEN, SUNSCREEN, SUNSCREEN!!!! Please be sure your Child has sunscreen (SPF 15+) on at the start of the day and brings along more to reapply throughout the day.**
- ✓ Sunglasses and or hat

A lot of our activities are outdoors, so please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for our changing Sierra weather. Remember that space is limited in the vans and campers will need to carry ALL of their own belongings on hikes and to other activities! **A sturdy backpack is the easiest** for your child to carry. Remember also, electronic devices are **NOT ALLOWED** (please see the "CODE of CONDUCT" for a full list of items "not allowed"). We believe that cell phones should be treated as communication tools, not toys. Please discuss with your camper the need for cell phones to be turned off and stored securely zipped in a backpack to minimize loss or damage and encourage program participation. We will turn them on and communicate with parents as needed during the day. If parents need to contact their child you can call the camp phone 530-448-9716.

Sessions and Payment Due Dates:

The camp schedule contains a diverse amount of activities including, but not limited to: hiking, swimming water parks, amusement parks. For a complete list of activities, please see the calendar. The activities for this camp are in and around the Tahoe Basin. We mostly stay here in the local area and Reno, except for a few trips to the Sacramento area. These trips will require us to leave earlier or arrive later than normal for camp (exact times will be published with **trip info about 1 week prior to each trip**)

Many trips will require campers to be around water. If your student is NOT comfortable around water (or can't swim) please speak with the Camp Rad Coordinator BEFORE you sign your camper up for camp!! 530-448-9716

There are 9 sessions of Camp Radical. All registration and payment is taken at the TDRPD office (8924 Donner Pass Rd.), which is open for business Monday through Thursday from 8 AM – 5:30 PM and Friday from 9 AM – 5 PM or online (follow the online registration link on our website). You may also pay with a credit card over the telephone at 530-582-7720 if you have already filled out a registration packet (available in **Forms** online at tdrpd.com. Fees are due in full at time of registration. **DO NOT BRING YOUR CHILD TO CAMP IF YOU HAVE NOT REGISTERED, THANK YOU!** You cannot leave your child at camp while you go to the office. If you register on the day of camp, please bring your receipt to camp to show proof of registration, so that your camper may be added to the roster. Take note that some days require a waiver form from the facility we are using and may not be available until the week or day of that trip. **Please make sure that releases are signed in advance if you do not bring your child to camp personally.**

Fees: Fees include transportation to and from activity, admission into activity, and supervision from our Camp Rad staff. Send your child with a big lunch & snacks + spending money, depending on the destination. Not sure? Ask our staff!

Families receiving subsidy from an outside agency are responsible for all fees not covered by the outside entity. It is the responsibility of the participants to communicate all fees to their provider and know what fees the provider covers. All outstanding participant fees must be paid before attending camp.

Regular Registration (on space-available basis)

Regular Day: \$40
Trip Day: From \$45 to \$60 Depends on trip, check our calendar.

Registration & Payments:

Please read thoroughly and direct any questions to the TDRPD office (530-582-7720).

Rainy Day policy:

When it rains, or the weather is excessively bad, and the activity for the day is dependent on good weather we will reschedule for weather appropriate activities. These activities may include (but are not limited to) the movies, TDRPD pool, bowling or climbing and bouldering at the Community Rec Center.

Refund/vacation/payment due policy:

Camp Radical fees follow the TDRPD Camp Refund policy. All fees are nonrefundable once paid. Fees may be transferred by the Tuesday the week before to another day at Camp Rad or a 50% credit or refund will be given to you. Certain trips, once paid are non-refundable, and the main office will be able to tell you which ones (paintball, Ropes course, etc.). Refund requests as a result of a camper's extended injury or illness are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. The parent must notify the TDRPD office (530-582-7720) in a timely manner and provide a doctor's excuse when requesting a refund for an extended illness or injury. A child removed or suspended from an activity by Camp Rad staff for inappropriate behavior is **NOT** entitled to a refund.

**EVERY DAY SWIMMING IS A POSSIBILITY ALWAYS BRING A SWIMSUIT,

Sign-in & Sign-out:

A parent/guardian must sign their camper in and out of camp on the roster EVERY day! Campers are not allowed to sign themselves in or out. The only people allowed to pick a child up from camp are parents and those on the emergency form. In the event someone not listed on the emergency form must pick up your camper, the camp counselors must receive a **written note** from the parent/guardian stating who will pick up the camper. Counselors will check identification of anyone picking up a camper. **Be sure to check for required waivers in advance if you (the parent) will not personally be delivering your child to camp.** Waiver days are listed on the detailed weekly info sheets, available midweek for the following week.

Illness/Injury:

If your camper is not feeling well, please do not bring him/her to camp! If a camper is brought to camp ill or becomes ill, we will call you to pick up your camper. **Please be sure to keep your emergency form phone numbers current so you can be reached immediately if your camper is ill or injured.** Our staff is trained in CPR and First Aid and will handle emergency situations as they have been taught. With the exception of life-threatening emergencies, effort will be made to reach an emergency contact person before calling professional medical personnel. If camp staff decides your camper needs immediate medical attention and/or emergency contacts are unavailable, professional medical personnel may be called to transport your camper to the hospital.

Medication

Campers may not administer or be in possession of medication during camp. If a child needs medication during camp hours, a Medication Administration form must be completed by the parent. Only prescription drugs in their original containers (with child's name and date) will be administered. No over the counter medication will be given without written instructions from the child's physician and or parent.

Bring Your Lunch A big lunch and two healthy snacks should be packed everyday. We do not stop for campers to purchase food on our trips unless it is an overnight trip and we have specified which meals we will purchase. Your child is permitted to bring money for a treat if there are vendors at the site for the day (Wild Island, West End Beach, Etc.) **Our treat Policy is: One Treat and One Drink.** Many of the activities that we do are highly active and require hearty, healthy food. We do not believe that the campers need excess sugar and junk food. **Do not send your child with Energy Drinks.** They will be confiscated and disposed of based on the effects it has on the campers.

PROGRAM CODE OF CONDUCT

The TDRPD Youth Programs Staff is gearing up for a fantastic summer filled with exciting games, and trips. It is our goal to maintain both a safe and fun camp environment. In order for planned camp activities to run smoothly, all campers will need to abide by a simple code of conduct. These guidelines are detailed below. It is important that each participant be familiar with the program rules before attending the first day of the program. Please go over the code of conduct with your child(ren) and make sure they have a good understanding of each rule. These are the basic behavior rules that are expected from each participant!

- I will do what I know is Right
- I will not hurt other people.
- I will be respectful of myself and other people.
- I will use good and appropriate language.
- I will tell the truth.
- I will treat property and equipment with respect and care.
- I will stay on site and with the group at all times unless I have authorized permission to leave.
- I will always stay with a buddy, unless I am with a counselor.
- I will not bring electronic devices such as Gameboy or PSP or use cell phone (except to contact parents or guardian.)
- I will follow all van guidelines
- I will not bring or wear anything that can be construed as disrespectful or inappropriate

Refunds are not issued for children that are suspended or dismissed from a program due to inappropriate behavior.

Any unused or unneeded fees for camp will be refunded up to 50%
