CAMP RADICAL

PROGRAM GOALS AND ACTIVITIES

We strive to provide a safe and fun recreational program, with an emphasis on regional activities and outdoor exploration. Experienced and trustworthy staff are hired and trained to meet the needs of all campers. Most of our trips are full day excursions, due to the active nature of kids in this age group.

In order to meet camper's needs, this program will:

- Promote safety first

- Promote positive camper-camper interactions and camper-staff interactions

- Encourage campers in developing decision-making skills

- Provide recreational, social and academically oriented activities and challenges

DAILY SCHEDULE

Camp Radical runs Monday through Thursday from 7:15 AM - 6:00 PM. Each day we will leave from, and return to the **Community Arts Center (10046 Church St)**. We will leave by **9:00 AM** each day for our activity, so make sure your camper is at the center by **8:30 AM**. There **WILL BE** days where we will leave earlier or return later than the regular times, and these will be reflected on the weekly agenda for you. Many of our activities require us to leave right on time, so **WE CANNOT WAIT FOR LATE CAMPERS**. Please call and let us know if your camper is not attending that day for any reason by **7:30 AM**. This will allow ample time for a camper on the waitlist to be added by the front office, as well as our team to adjust arrangements as needed.

The camp schedule contains a diverse amount of activities. Trip activities include, but are not limited to: hiking, swimming, water parks, ropes courses, and amusement parks. For a complete list of activities, please see the calendar. The activities for this camp are in and around the Reno/Tahoe Basin. However, we do have a few trips in the Sacramento area. These trips may require us to leave earlier and/or arrive later than normal times, and these times will be noted in the weekly agenda.

Our camp closes at 6 PM, SHARP. We will charge parents a late fee if they arrive late to pick up their camper. If a camper has not been picked up by 6:30pm and staff is unable to contact anyone off the emergency form, your camper will be placed in the custody of the Truckee Police Department. Habitual lateness may result in permanent dismissal from our camp.

WHAT TO BRING

- ✓ **SWIMSUITS EVERYDAY!!!**
- ✓ (Ladies, please no string bikinis or short shorts...they just don't work)
- ✓ Good shoes
- ✓ Substantial water shoes (ie Tevas or Keens) for water days/activities
- ✓ Lunch and snacks (we have long days in the sun, so pack extras!)
- ✓ Towels, layered clothing, light-weight rain jacket (for potential T-Storms)
- ✓ **LOTS of DRINKING WATER** (Minimum 1 Liter)
- ✓ **SUNSCREEN, SUNSCREEN, SUNSCREEN!!!!** Please be sure your child has sunscreen (SPF 15+) on at the start of the day and brings more to reapply throughout the day.
- ✓ Sunglasses and/or hat
- ✓ *Optional money*.... there will be days that we will be places where there is a snack bar

A lot of our activities are outdoors, so please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for our changing Sierra weather. Remember that space is limited in the vans and campers will need to carry ALL of their own belongings on hikes and to other activities! A sturdy backpack is the easiest for your child to carry. Remember, electronic devices are **NOT ALLOWED** (please see the "Code of Conduct" for a full list of items "not allowed"). We believe that cell phones should be treated as communication tools, not toys. Please discuss with your camper the need for cell phones to be turned off and stored securely zipped in a backpack to minimize loss or damage, and encourage program participation. We will turn them on and communicate with parents as needed during the day. If parents need to contact their child, it's best to call the camp cell phone at 530-4489716

Many of our trips will require campers to be around water. If your child is NOT comfortable around water (or can't swim) please speak with the Camp Rad Coordinator BEFORE you sign your camper up for camp

CAMP REGISTRATION AND FEES

There are 9 sessions of Camp Radical. Registration is **NOT** available at camp location. All registration must be done at the front office at the Community Rec Center located at: (8924 Donner Pass Road). Phone number (530)-582-7720. Business hours are Monday/Tuesday 8-5:30, Wed/Thur. 9-5:30 and Friday 9-5pm. You may also pay with a credit card over the phone at 530-582-7720 **ONLY IF** you have already filled out a registration packet.

DO NOT BRING YOUR CHILD TO CAMP IF YOU HAVE NOT REGISTERED FOR THAT DAY, THANK YOU! You cannot leave your child at camp while you go to the office to register. If you register on the day of camp, please bring your receipt to camp to show proof of registration and we can add your child to the roster. Take note that some trips require a waiver form from the facility we are using and may not be available until the week or day of that trip. Please make sure that releases are signed in advance if you do not bring your child to camp personally.

Regular Registration: Regular fees apply until 4:30pm on the Friday before the upcoming week. You can register online or in person (remember office closes at 5pm on Friday). **Online registration WILL CLOSE on Friday.**

REMEMBER TO ALWAYS PICK UP A WEEKLY AGENDA, EITHER FROM THE CAMP RAD ROOM OR THE FRONT OFFICE

Payment Plan: If your camp fees total more than \$1,000 per kid, per camp; you have the option to pay half at the time of registration and the other half on July 5th. This option requires a valid credit card saved on file with TDRPD. Payment must go through within 5 days. If it does not go through, your child will be removed from all remaining camp days.

Scholarships: The Truckee Donner Recreation & Park District offers scholarships that are available for those who qualify. Awards for camp are between 20%-60% off daily admission, depending on household income. Please contact camp director or the main office for more information and to apply.

POLICIES & EXPECTATIONS

Refund Policy

Cancellations must happen in writing on or before the Tuesday prior to the week you are cancelling/modifying, in order to receive a credit or refund of 50%. You may transfer these cancelled days to another day in the same camp, if available, by email or written request. A \$5 transfer fee will apply to all transfers. **We do not offer refunds if your child is suspended from the program for disciplinary reasons.**

Illness/Injury

If your child is not feeling well, please don't bring them to camp. We do not have the facilities nor the staff members to take care of your sick child. If your camper becomes ill during the day, a staff member will call the parents immediately and ask that you pick them up within 45 minutes. **Refunds for extended illness or injury are reviewed on a case-by-case basis, and require a doctor's note.**

Staff has been trained in first aid, CPR and basic water safety. In the event of a life-threatening medical emergency, we will call 911. For the most part, however, a parent or emergency contact will receive the first call. **PLEASE MAKE SURE TO HAVE THE MOST UP-TO-DATE PHONE NUMBERS ON YOUR CAMPER'S EMERGENCY FORM, IN ORDER TO BE REACHED IMMEDIATELY IN THE EVENT THAT YOUR CAMPER IS ILL OR INJURED.**

Rainy Day

We do not cancel camp for rainy days. If camp had an outdoor activity scheduled, camp directors will find alternate activities and let the parents know of the change at drop off time. Always pack a bathing suit for your kids on rainy days, as our swimming pool is a great indoor activity!

Medications

Please advise the camp director **before the campers first day** if your child has a medication they need to take throughout the course of the day. Every attempt will be made to accommodate your camper's needs. Camp staff will keep your campers medication with them and administer if necessary. Parents will need to fill out a "Medication Administration" form and give to camp directors.

Electronics

No electronics, including cell phones, tablets or i-pods are allowed during program hours. We will allow the use in emergency situations. If campers continually use their devices, staff will confiscate and return to the guardian at pick-up.

Van Etiquette

In our long time working with kids and at camps, we have noticed that campers tend to forget all of the rules and manners that were taught to them as soon as they get in a van for a trip. It is imperative that campers adhere to the rules, in order to maintain a safe and fun environment while traveling to out destinations. Here are some general guidelines for riding in our vans:

- **No food in the van**
- **Seatbelts must be worn at all times**
- **Load the front of van first**
- **No cursing, screaming or general misbehaving**
- **Bring a book or something quiet to occupy your time**

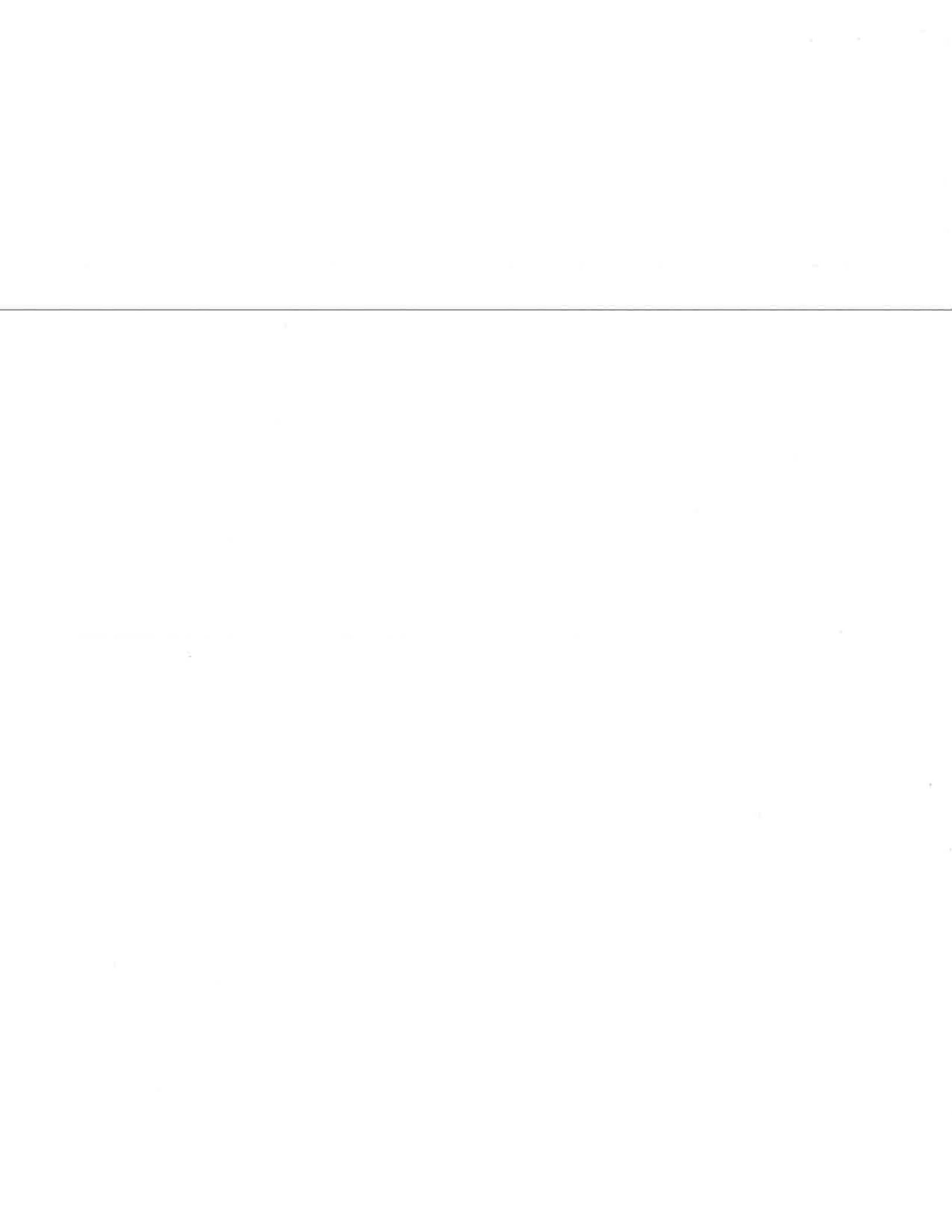

The TDRPD Youth Programs Staff is gearing up for a fantastic summer filled with exciting games, and trips. It is our goal to maintain both a safe and fun camp environment. In order for planned camp activities to run smoothly, all campers will need to abide by a simple code of conduct. These guidelines are detailed below. It is important that each participant be familiar with the program rules before attending the first day of the program. - I will not bring or wear anything that can be construed as disrespectful or inappropriate

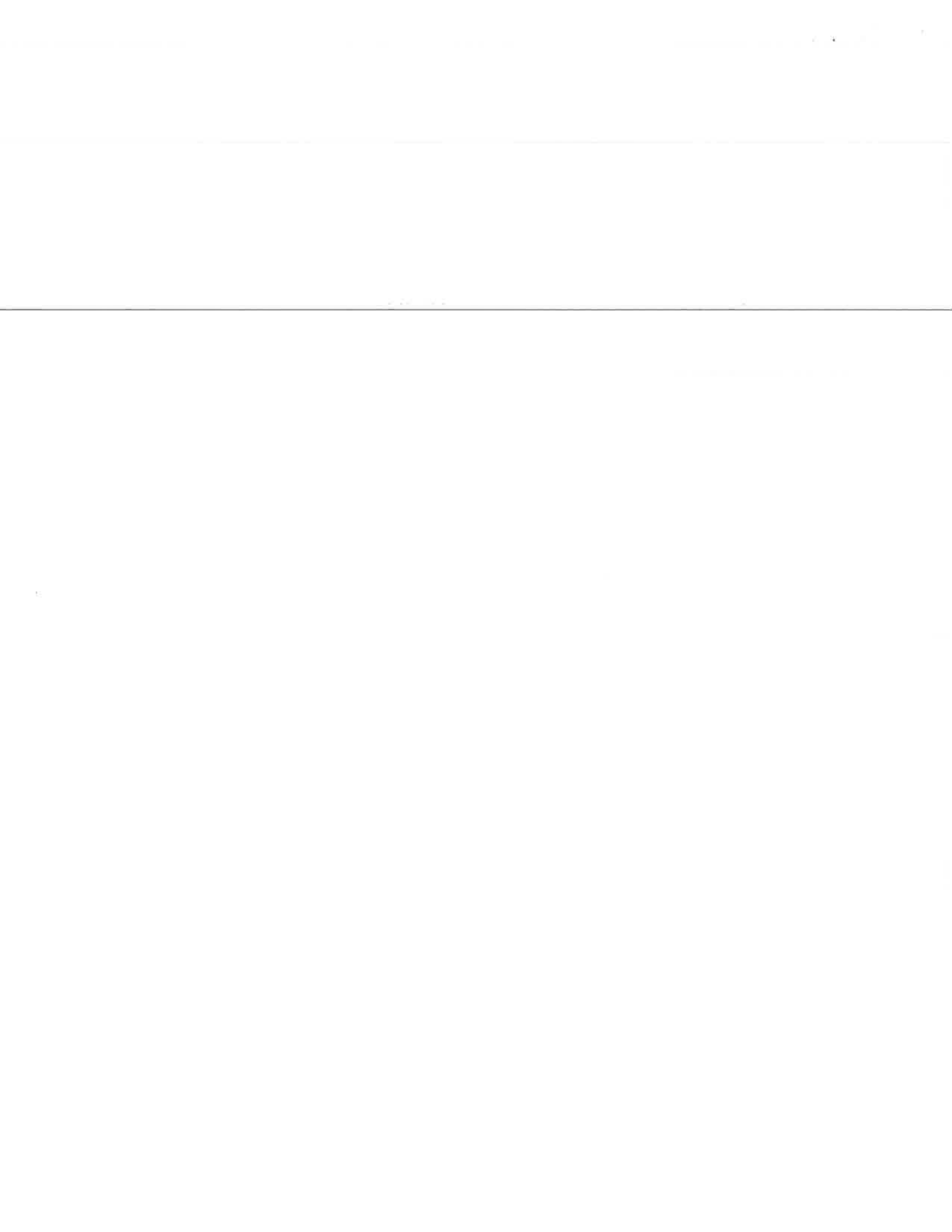
